

Yarra Foundation Membership Terms and Conditions

- The Purpose of the Foundation is to support provision of education for disadvantaged children in Iran.
- Yarra Foundation has no religious or political interest.
- A person becomes a member when:
 - The Foundation has approved person's application to join the Association;
 - The Foundation has received the person's subscription fee, and
 - The Membership Manager has entered the person's name, address and the date they requested membership on the members' registry.
- If we receive more than annual membership fee, we assume that the extra has been donated to Yarra Foundation account.
- If an applicant lives outside Australia or is under the age of 15, she/he will be able to join Yarra Foundation as an Associate Member.

Members and Associate members:

- Only Members have the right to vote in General Meetings and are eligible to be elected or appointed to the Management Committee
- Both Members and Associate Members may (subject to Yarra Rules) inspect the rules of the Association, General Meeting minutes, and relevant documents as defined in the Act.
- Both Members and Associate Members' contact details will only be used to send materials relating to the membership, events information, newsletters and any other information related to purpose of Yarra foundation.
- Membership fees are nonrefundable.
